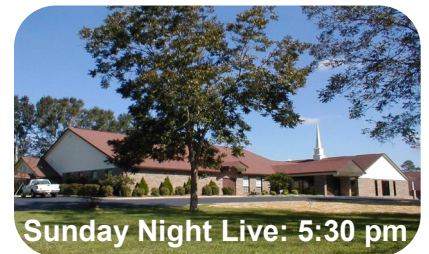

From the desk of Senior Pastor Joel Treick

Hebrews 4:8-9⁸ For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not have spoken of another day later on.⁹ So then, there remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God.



As I write this, I'm looking out the window at Pensacola Beach. I don't normally write newsletter articles at the beach, but I'm taking a short sabbatical. The elders thought it would be good for me to get away for a few days, so I could have some time to read, pray and dream about the future of our church.

On one level, I'm very thankful to have the time away. May was a crazy month at the Treick house. We packed up and moved to a new house, which was (and is!) a big undertaking. It's strange, because we only moved about 5 miles, but there's still a lot of packing, unpacking, and organizing to do. (You temporarily lose a lot of things when you move, which is stressful. I remember spending 15 minutes one morning looking for my black socks. For some reason, I packed all my black socks in a box and I couldn't remember which one!) On top of the move, our daughter has her big year-end dance recital this weekend ... which means long practices, coordinating rides, and even learning my part for the Daddy-Daughter Dance! (Thankfully, they gave me a spot on the back row this year ... so there's a little less pressure on me!) Kate's been busy with work, photographing somewhere around 100 dancers, trying to find a new studio space, decorating, planning, and coaxing me back when I get a little bit too close to the emotional ledge.

But even with all that going on ... it's still hard for me to rest! At one point, before my sabbatical, I even started **scheduling** my rest. I thought to myself, "Okay, when I wake up ... I'll spend an hour reading the Bible and praying ... I'll eat breakfast ... I'll go get some exercise ... I'll come back and read ... I'll journal ... I'll come back over the bridge to meet with this person and that person ..." I found myself thinking about emails that would go unanswered, tasks that would go unfinished, and eventually I had to stop and ask myself a question. "Why can't you let this go? Why is this so hard for you?"

I think the answer is ... I have a hard time trusting God sometimes. Intellectually, I know that God is faithful, I know that he's sovereign, I know that he loves me ... but sin is irrational. Sin makes us forget the truth. Sin makes us doubt God's promises. Sin makes us think, "If I don't do this work ... everything will fall apart!" I think that's why God invented the Sabbath. I think he built rest into the regular rhythm of our lives to remind us, "I've got this. I'm in control." Sabbath forces us to re-think the nature of reality. It reminds us that we're part of something much bigger ... a story that God has been writing, and faithful men and women have been telling and re-telling, since the beginning of the world! When God created the world, he worked for six days, and rested on the seventh. When Jesus rose again and ascended to heaven, he sat down at the right hand of God. When Jesus comes back, he will call us to himself, and we will enter what the writer of Hebrews calls "a Sabbath rest" that "remains for the people of God."

One of the things I love about God is his ability to put flesh and bones on abstract concepts and ideas. God could have simply explained what the end of the age will be like, but instead he allows us to experience a foretaste of it every Sunday morning.

When Jesus comes again, he will meet all our physical needs ... therefore, we can spend our Sundays resting from “such worldly employments ... as are lawful on other days.” When Jesus comes again, we will be so overwhelmed by his glory and grace that we will worship him forever and ever ... therefore, we can spend our Sundays “in the public and private exercises of God’s worship.” When Jesus comes again, there will be no more poverty, oppression, pain, or sorrow ... therefore, we can spend our Sundays “taking up works of ... mercy.” (See *Westminster Shorter Catechism, Q&A 60.*)

What a gift! What a gift to be able to enter the age to come ... every Sunday! It’s like we’re the children who were allowed to climb into Narnia ... to experience the real world for the very first time! Are you making the most of that gift or are you neglecting it? Is Sunday a special day for you ... or is it business as usual? Do you worship out of a sense of duty ... or do you worship God out of a deep sense of gratitude for his grace? Do you see mercy, hospitality, and kindness as your opportunity to give a tiny taste of Sabbath rest to other people?

With all that in mind, I’m going to stop writing and get back to resting! I’m praying that the Holy Spirit will use these few days away to hit “control-alt-delete” on my sinful tendency to think that I’m in charge of everything. (I’m not!) I’m praying that he will use the Bible to press gospel truths deep into my heart! (How quickly do I forget!) I’m praying that he will remind me that he loves me more than I could ever imagine ... and I’m also praying, that as God fills me up, I would joyfully pour myself out for you ... over and over again ... until the day God ushers me into that eternal Sabbath rest.

What if God made Pinewoods a place where weary people experienced God’s rest? Wouldn’t that be amazing? (I think it would!) May God make it so ...

Missionary Updates

Darlene Johnson – Mission to the World (MTW) in Nagoya, Japan

- Pray for her as she gets used to life in Japan again after a year of HMA in the US.
- Pray for new friendships among the Wed. night College Student Ministry as they begin their new school year. Pray for Ramon, the only Christian student in the group. Pray for leaders, Mr. & Mr. Uechi.
- Praise that Darlene's former neighbors came to church on Easter! Husband, wife Tomoko and their daughter all came. Pray for fruitful follow-up with this friendship.

Tony & Amber Elswick – MTW in Managua, Nicaragua

- III Millennium Seminary Training Courses advance steadily; a pastor reports that he finds joy in preaching after formerly not knowing how to understand the Word. Pray that this free Reformed seminary-level training will impact many to build the Lord's church in Nicaragua.
- Over 50 Nicaraguan pastors attended a 2-day seminar on how to facilitate more groups.
- Church Planter Training Retreat was completed in May.
- Phase 2 was completed in May; 10 pastors meet 3 days every 3 mos. for 2 yrs.
- Purpose to pray for: that the Lord would move in pastor's hearts and strengthen the church in Nicaragua.

Mark & Nicola Faires serve with SEND North in North Pole, Alaska

- Thank God for funds that have come in to purchase a Cessna 206 aircraft! Enough has come in to pay for desired improvements and maintenance. Mark will fly this plane to remote villages for missionary support, ministry trips, work team travel, and summer Bible camp support. They thank Pinewoods for the generous donation toward the purchase of the plane.
- Send North is recruiting "boots on the ground" for ministry work north of Fairbanks. Many villages lack any Christian presence. There are many opportunities for believers to be lights in the dark. "To augment financial support, there are positions in post offices, airports, schools, and medical facilities that are often left vacant in rural Alaska due to the demanding nature of the environment."
- Thank God that work continues on the guest house as God sends teams to complete drywall, painting, and carpentry work. Mark will be setting up an aircraft fueling station near their home to save flight time at \$230/hr.
- Ask God for a safe delivery for Baby Faires in June. 3 yr. old Winston and 1 ½ yr. old Evelyn will be good playmates for the little one.

Fred & Jean Klett lead CHAIM (Christians Announcing Israel's Messiah)

- Pray for and join the evangelism team in Philadelphia July 1–8. Work with the Chaim team in street outreach during Independence Week celebrations. They need both experienced lay persons and teachable trainees to sharing the Good News. Contact (215)576-7325.
- Pray for the results of door-to-door ministry for Russian-speaking neighborhoods in NE Philadelphia that were held in May. This work was done to boost the Rock of Israel PCA church plant.

Far East Broadcasting Company (FEBC) is a 75 year-old organization.

As Lenda lay in the Jakarta, Indonesia, hospital, she told the story of her life. Although she grew up in the home of her godly aunt, she left the Lord to marry a Muslim. He was very angry about her faith and beat her often. She began to pray for God, "When will you allow me to worship you freely?" She read her Bible each day, but her husband took it away many times and destroyed it.

She happened on a FEBC Heartline program on the radio. The sound preaching of the word of God refreshed her soul, although she had to listen to it in secret. Finally, her husband cast her and her children out.

Lenda's godly aunt welcomed her and the children into her home. However, Lenda's health deteriorated until she could not walk for three years. But she praised God that she could finally worship God freely. She was convinced God had a beautiful plan for her life, and she thanked him for his grace in delivering her family out of Islam. Listening to FEBC radio strengthened her soul. She is with the Lord now.

Clay & Darlene Quarterman serve with MTW in Kiev, Ukraine.

- Clay and Darlene sent us a lovely Ukrainian Easter card. "Dear Friends at Pinewoods, Christ has risen in the hearts of many Ukrainians. Thank you for your part in our ministry. Keep praying for Ukraine! Love, Clay and Darlene." Clay and Darlene have been MTW missionaries for well over 35 years, serving first in Portugal, but much longer in Ukraine.
- Clay is a professor at the Evangelical Reformed Seminary of Ukraine. Recently your Pinewoods Missions Team was able to give a one-time gift to pay for nationals to train as pastors. Some are from war-torn Eastern Ukraine, where Russian troops still occupy. We thank the congregation for their generosity for the Pinewoods mission fund.

Scott & Christine serve with LDI in a sensitive ministry.

- Praise God for recent opportunities for Pastor Turgay to meet with local church leaders in Ethiopia, Greece, and churches in the U.S. Pray for pastor's health as he had to cut the U.S. visit short because of health issues that have since be resolved. Scott continued by visiting an additional four churches.
- LDI is seeking funding to buy several hundred additional Bibles; visitors have taken Bibles that were offered. Pray for the power of the Word to be unleashed in the hearts of the readers. Make donations online at MTW/LDI project 95836.

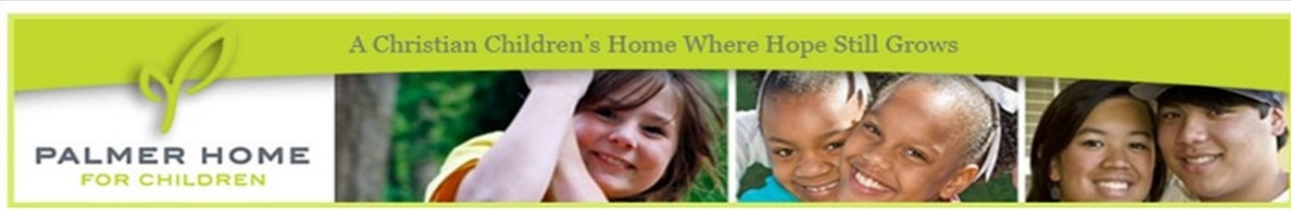

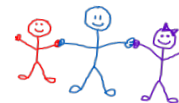
