From the desk of Senior Pastor Joel Treick

As I write this, I'm listening to the rain fall outside my window and I'm listening to a haunting rendition of a song called "It is Well," by Kristene Dimarco and Bethel Music.

*So let go, my soul, and trust in Him
The waves and wind still know His name*

It is well with my soul.

Those words, accompanied by the sound of the rain, remind me of the heartbreak and sorrow being experienced by so many people in Houston. The *New York Times* reports, "The slow-moving, record-shattering tropical storm Harvey battered the region for a sixth straight day and began to move into southwest Louisiana, where it made its second landfall early Wednesday (8/30/17) morning. With hundreds of thousands of people under evacuation orders, shelters in Houston filled to bursting with people who craved some news about the safety of their loved ones and the state of their homes."

The numbers are mind-blowing. Four days. 51.88 inches of rain. More than a trillion gallons of water. (According to the *New York Times* website, "That's the equivalent to all of the precipitation from the past 6 months in the Pensacola, FL area – in just one week.") 30 confirmed deaths. 6,100 people rescued by government agencies and many more by Good Samaritans who are going door-to-door rescuing people with boats.

What can we do about it?

The first thing we can do it **pray**. The other day in Sunday School, we were asked to talk about one of our favorite Bible verses, and this is the one I choose. "Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth. Then he prayed again, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth bore its fruit." (James 5:17-18)

What an amazing promise, especially in light of this terrible storm! Do you believe that? I do. I believe that if God's people will go to God in prayer, he can do **anything**. He can reduce the power of this storm. He can guide rescuer workers to the right places. He can restrain evil people who might otherwise use this disaster as a way to exploit or harm the weak and the vulnerable. He can mobilize churches. He can provide financial resources, by moving his people to give. Please pray!

The second thing you can do is **donate**. If you can give money, please write a check to Pinewoods Presbyterian Church, specifying "Texas Flood Relief." If you can give supplies, we need the following items:

For Cleaning and Flood Kits:



FROM THE SENIOR PASTOR (continued)

- One 5-gallon bucket with re-sealable lid
 - ◇ New buckets are preferred and can be purchased at Lowes, Home Depot, Ace Hardware, etc. Used buckets from food service or restaurants are permissible if properly washed. Buckets which have stored chemicals, paint, pool chemicals, etc., are not permissible.
- 5 scouring pads.
 - ◇ Remove from packaging. No stainless steel, no Brillo or SOS pads-no soap built in.
- 7 sponges (dry only)
 - ◇ Remove from packaging. No cellulose sponges due to mold issues.
- 18 cleaning wipes (reusable, non-linen); Handi-wipes types; no terry cleaning towels.
- Liquid laundry detergent 50 oz. (2-25 oz. or 1-50 oz.)
- 1 household cleaner, 12-16 oz. plastic bottle
- 1 disinfectant dish soap, 16-28 oz. plastic bottle
- 50 clothes pins
- Clothes line (two 50 ft. or one 100 ft.) Cotton or plastic
- 5 dust masks
- 2 pair heavy-duty reusable latex gloves
- 1 pair leather palm work gloves; cotton with leather palm or totally leather
- 24-bag roll of heavy-duty trash bags, 33-45 gallon size.
- 1 insect repellent spray, 6-14 oz. plastic bottle w/protective cap
- Air freshener, 8 or 9 oz. bottle w/protective cap

For Hygiene Kits:

- 1 hand towel
 - ◇ 15" x 17" works best; do not exceed 17" x 27" or the contents will not fit in the bag
 - ◇ kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels are not acceptable
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb
 - ◇ sturdy and 6" or longer only
 - ◇ pocket combs or picks not appropriate
 - ◇ rat-tail and handleless combs are ok as long as the comb has 6" of teeth
- 1 stainless nail clipper
- 1 nail file (no emery boards, please)
- 1 bath-size bar soap
 - ◇ individually wrapped, 3 oz. and larger sizes only
 - ◇ no Ivory or Jergens allowed due to moisture content
 - ◇ liquid soaps not allowed
 - ◇ do not remove from original packaging
- 1 toothbrush
 - ◇ adult size only
 - ◇ do not remove from original packaging
- 1 toothpaste squeezable tube
- 6 adhesive bandages, Band-Aid type
 - ◇ ¾" to 1" size
- 1 sealable plastic bag
 - ◇ one-gallon size sealable bag only

Important to Know:

- All items must be new.
- Do not wash any of the items or they will be considered used and not allowed.
- Please remove all packaging except bar of soap wrapping.
- Do not include any personal notes, money, or additional material in the kits.

Thursday from 9am to 3:30pm; and Friday from 9am to 11:30am. **Deadline is Tuesday, September 5th.**

You can donate your time. We will be assembling emergency kits on **Wednesday, September 6th** in the **Fellowship Hall**. (Stay tuned for a specific time. We'll keep you informed via email, Facebook, and announcements from the pulpit.)

You can go to the flood zone. Pinewoods will be sending a team to the Houston Metro area for five days. If you would like to go in person, you will need to register with Mission to North America via their website. (<http://stat.pcanet.org/mna/disasterresponse/signin.cfm>) All volunteers must be at least 21 years old, as volunteers will be primarily doing debris removal in affected homes. The situation is fluid, but the tentative leave-date is **September 8th**.

Houston needs our help! All of us can pray. Most of us can give. Some of us can go. Please do what you can, that God's name might be glorified as we love and serve our neighbors. Someone in Houston might be praying ... **right now**. Will you be God's answer to that person's prayers? I hope so.

PRAYING FOR OUR PINWOODS MISSIONARIES

Bruce & Pam Sinclair serve with Mission to the World in Kampala, Uganda.

- “We could not be on the field without people like you on the home front. We are truly grateful! Pam is a member of Pinewoods.
- A great need of the African church is training for pastors; the church is growing so very fast, but few pastors have a seminary education. In the African setting, it is best for teaching to be done in a relational setting mentoring and modeling—and sometimes in a smaller group outside of Kampala since pastors cannot travel to a different country or city to study. A 3-year course of study for a master of divinity degree costs \$4,000 total (1/25th of the cost of sending someone to the U. S. for theological training). Scholarship funds are needed to train pastors for Uganda, South Sudan, Rwanda, Burundi, Republic of Congo and Rural Kenya (all of East Africa).
- Pray for those pastors who have completed their education and serve in war-torn places; pray for the ongoing reach of the Gospel where pastors have given their lives to stay in areas where war continues. Pray for the thousands from South Sudan living in a refugee camp in Uganda.
- Pray for the faculty, staff, and students at African Bible University, Westminster Christian Institute Uganda, and Africa Reformation Theological Seminary as they prepare for the new school year. Especially ask God to bring the students of His choosing and to provide for their financial needs.
- Bruce has developed Type 2 diabetes; pray that it will be under good control. Pray for healing so this disease may not be permitted to hinder his participation in God’s Kingdom work.
- Pray that the Sinclair’s adult children, Tim and Celeste, will find godly spouses and marriages. Tim is in Tuscon, AZ, and Celeste teaches in Uganda.
- Pray for more ministry workers at New City Church in Kampala. Please also pray for their life-on-life mentoring ministry and officer training beginning this fall.

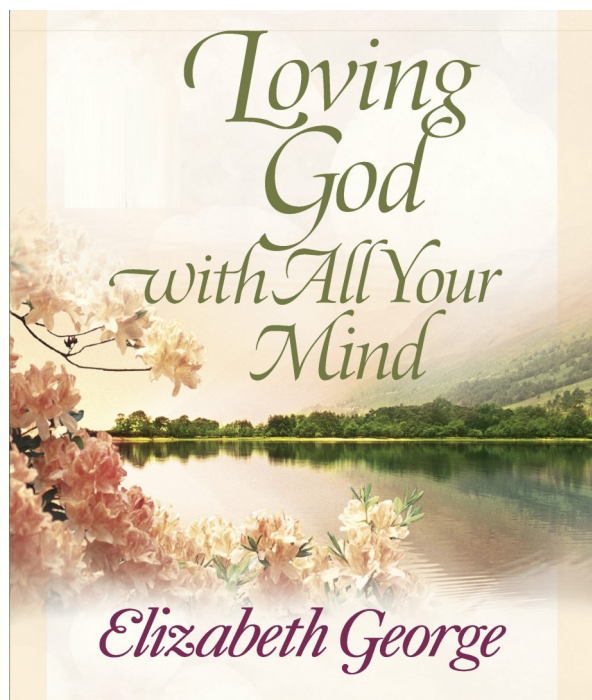
